In 1958, a fire at Chicago's Our Lady of the Angels School killed 92 children and three nuns. Romano (If

You Eat, You Never Die, 2008), a lifelong Chicagoan, is too young to remember its immediate aftermath,

but the stories he grew up hearing inspired his latest novel. Almost a decade after the fire, 20-year-old

Anthony Lazzeri is wracked by survivor's guilt, while many in the community, including members of his

own family, still find the tragedy far too painful to talk about. When he discovers that his neighbor, a

retired detective, still actively suspects him of starting the fire, Anthony attempts to piece together his

fragmented memories with the help of his childhood sweetheart. She is a fellow survivor of the fire and

possesses some unsettling knowledge about its strange effects on Anthony's psyche and confused

perception of his body and self. By turns a detective story, a psychological thriller, and a meditation on

grief and loss, Romano's sensitive tale explores the lasting effects of trauma on individuals, families, and

entire communities.
